


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Our nation's surgeon general issued a call to action in 2014 to prevent skin cancer. Recall the infamous warning back in 1966 regarding smoking and cancer?

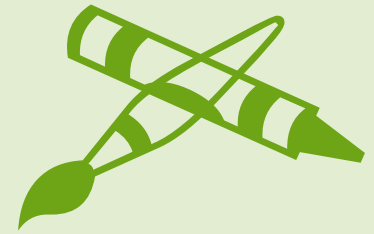

2016-2017 REGISTRATION EXTENDED DAY

The registration process remains without change for our Extended Day Enrichment Program (EDEP). The District EDEP Specialist reported it was implemented last year due to high demand & space limitations at many schools. One must follow procedures and timelines listed below to be eligible for enrollment.

- »Monday 4/25/16 through Monday 5/9/16 parents/guardians must pick-up, complete & return an "Intent to Enroll" form from school facilitator during program hours. When you return it completed, you will receive written confirmation your form has been received.
- »May 16&17, EDEP District Specialist randomly draws names & assigns a space in the program at sites where more "Intent to Enroll" forms were received than spaces allow. Once all spaces are assigned, a waiting list will be established.
- »Thursday, May 19 a list will be posted in a designated area at each school identifying students selected for enrollment.
- »**It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to call or check the list.**
- »All eligible students' paperwork, registration & fees due to site facilitator by Friday, May 27 @5:45 p.m.*
- »Your space in the program is forfeited if payment not received by deadline".
- »All past due balances must be paid in full in order to register for the 2016-2017 year.
